### Parent Rights

All parents of our students have the right to know:

- a:** Whether the State of Arizona has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subject he or she teaches.
- b:** Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency permit or other provisional status by which state licensing criteria have been waived.
- c:** The teacher's college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
- d:** Whether any instructional aides or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.
