- The FAFSA is used to determine most school-level grants and scholarships. You should start it as soon as possible.

 - Be sure to apply to more than one school.
 - Most schools have an application fee. See Mr. S if you have low family income.
 - If you are undecided, make sure the school offers the programs you want or might be interested in.

 - Mandatory dorm room
 - Mandatory food plan
 - Any other requirements for students.
